

Construction Update Montpelier Transportation Projects

Project Location: State Street, Main Street, and VT 12 – Elm Street - Work to include milling, paving, manhole and drainage structure adjustments and extensive sidewalk improvements. VT 12-Northfield Street - new water, sewer, storm water improvements, sidewalks and a stabilized road base.

Northfield Street: Weather permitting, Pike is scheduled to pave the base layer of new pavement on Northfield Street on Tuesday (11/14) and Wednesday (11/15).

Northfield Street Traffic Detour: During paving, southbound Northfield Street traffic will be directed to use Memorial Drive to National Life Drive to Derby Drive. Northbound traffic will use Northfield Street. Residents who live on Northfield Street will have to access their driveway heading in the North direction and should expect limited access to and from their driveway as the crews pave by the entrance.

Week of November 13th, 2017 Elm Street –

- Driveway entrances have been paved but are not complete. Crews will be placing topsoil and cleaning around entrances to bring them to completion.

State/Main/Elm Streets – Day Work

- Monday (11/13) – Line striping repairs will occur in various areas throughout the project. Street parking will be blocked off in the areas scheduled for repair and re-opened as the work is completed.

Traffic - Travel will be reduced to one lane with alternating one-way traffic maintained by flaggers. Motorists can expect traffic delays all week.

Northfield Street Update

Roadway: Weather permitting, Pike is scheduled to pave the base layer of new pavement on Northfield Street Tuesday (11/14) and Wednesday (11/15).

Traffic Detour: During paving, southbound Northfield Street traffic will be directed to use Memorial Drive to National Life Drive to Derby Drive. Northbound traffic will use Northfield Street. Residents who live on Northfield Street will have to access their driveway heading in the North direction and should expect limited access to and from their driveway as the crews pave by the entrance.

Guardrail: Following paving, crews will install new guardrail beginning at Prospect Street for 400' south.

Sidewalks: Crews will continue sidewalk work in various areas, weather permitting. It is expected that remaining sidewalks will be poured on 11/10/17 or 11/13/17, depending on weather conditions.

General Clean-up: Crews will be grading, placing topsoil and seed in disturbed areas throughout the project.

Traffic: Traffic on Northfield Street will ONLY be allowed to head in the Northbound Direction during paving operations. Traffic will be encouraged to use either Dog River Road (Alternate Route) or Derby Drive (Detour Route) while this work is occurring. Traffic wanting to travel North through the construction zone should expect delays.

It is illegal in VT to use any handheld portable electronic devices while driving. The law carries fines of up to \$200 with points assessed if the violation occurs in a work zone.

**Construction Update
Roxbury Northfield (VT 12A)
ER STP 0187(13)**

Project Location: The project extends along VT 12A from about ¾ of a mile north of the Granville/Roxbury Town Line in Roxbury to the Northfield Village Limits for a distance of 9.6 miles.

Week of November 13th, 2017

All work this week is weather dependent. If it rains, work will be rescheduled. Along with all work listed below, crews will be performing general clean-up work and addressing punch list items.

Most of the work this week will occur throughout the project as follows:

- Drive aprons and side road entrances will continue to be paved.
- Crews will complete the remaining line striping on side roads, weather permitting.
- Sign crews may install the remaining signs.
- Crews will be installing expansion joints in Northfield.

Travel will be reduced to one lane with alternating one way traffic around all operations. Flaggers will be present to assist in maintaining traffic flow.

Traffic – Traffic delays are expected this week.
