

Construction Update: Montpelier Transportation Projects, Proposed Schedule Week of 10/22/18

Montpelier STP 2950(1) [Northfield Street, downtown Montpelier] Update:

Remaining work includes:

Paving of driveway aprons and various areas located in front of crosswalk tip downs is scheduled to be done on Friday, 10/19 weather and temperatures permitting.

Bridge joint repair by Shaw's remains. This work is currently scheduled to be completed next week. This operation is weather and temperature dependent.

Reconstruction of drain Inlet by the RR tracks on Main St. as well as new paint markings at this location are scheduled for next week.

Other pavement marking locations include the crosswalk at Barre Street and repairing tape long lines on Elm Street. This is scheduled to occur next week.

The above scheduled work is dependent on weather and surface conditions. The construction schedule and anticipated construction activities is subject to change. In the event that any scheduled operation will have a moderate impact on the traveling public, a project alert will be released.

Proposed Schedule, Week of 10/22/18, Montpelier-Waterbury IM SURF (59) [I-89 Paving Project]

Project Location: The I-89 Paving Project begins south of Exit 8 and continues to a point just south of Exit 10 (Mile Marker 62.30). The total length of the project is 10.7 miles and will include both the north and southbound lanes of travel. Work to be performed includes milling and paving 3/4" of the road surface, work on bridge joints, and guardrail repair.

Work on this project will mainly be performed at night. Some work will be completed during non-peak daytime hours. Nighttime work hours are 7:00 PM-6:00 AM, and a typical work week is Sunday night through Friday morning. Some Friday night work may occur throughout the duration of this project.

BRIDGE JOINTS: Work on bridge joints will continue, weather and temperature conditions permitting.

GUARDRAIL: Guardrail work will be ongoing.

PAVING: Paving of U-Turns has been completed.

TRAFFIC INFORMATION: A work zone speed limit of 55 mph is in place throughout the project. There are increased fines for speed violations within the construction zone.

Please focus on safety when driving through the construction work zone and remember, it is against the law to use a hand held cell phone while driving in Vermont.
